

Did you know that you can create powerful leadership-learning connections by asking the right questions about a movie you've watched? Cue up (again) that movie that has been playing on repeat at home or get ready for your Friday family movie tradition, and consider these tips to invite leadership learning through movies.

- Consider selecting movies that teach relevant and needed lessons for the specific audience. Are you hoping students will make healthier choices? Do you want them to learn perseverance in difficult times? Would you like to show them what good leadership looks like?
- Make a habit of engaging in discussion before, during, and after the movie. When you've hit pause and you're taking that bathroom or snack break, throw out some "wonderings" and explore each other's thinking.
- Create a safe space for personal expression by responding to answers with an open mind and flexibility.
- Honor all answers, regardless of your viewpoint, while gently stretching everyone's thinking.

Grab a bowl of popcorn and gear up for exciting leadership discussions!


